Colombo district shows the highest departure for foreign employment during the period from 2003 to 2007. However, it is very significant that, Kurunegala district is continuing its increasing trend showing up to 2006 and there is a decrease of by 6,076 persons in year 2007. Gampaha, Kalutara, Kandy, Galle and Anuradhapuira districts indicate relatively higher departures.

It can be seen from the distribution of departures in 2007 for foreign employment by the districts and the country, from Kurunegala district 8,472 persons have gone to Saudi Arabia followed by 6,852 from Colombo district and 4,836 from Ampara district.
